In addition, include in that proposal a methodology for determining fees charged to profesio such that fees will be set for four year periods.

OCCUPATIONAL REGULATION

This bill requires the department of regulation and licensing (DORL) to prepare proposed legislation that establishes a process for annually evaluating the necessity of at least ~~two-thirds~~ of the credentialing boards in DORL and eliminating the credentialing boards that are unnecessary. The proposed legislation must also establish credential renewal fees that must be paid every four years rather than every two years as required under current law. DORL must submit the proposed legislation to the governor and the legislature no later than August 1, 2000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 9142. Nonstatutory provisions; regulation and licensing.

3 (1) PROPOSED LEGISLATION; CREDENTIALING BOARDS AND CREDENTIAL RENEWAL FEES.

4 The department of regulation and licensing shall prepare proposed legislation that establishes a regular and orderly process for the department to evaluate annually
