STATE EMPLOYMENT

(JCF)
Under current law, with certain exceptions, positions in state government may only be authorized by the legislature by law or in budget determinations, by the joint committee on finance and by the governor creating or abolishing certain positions funded from federal revenues. This bill authorizes the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System to increase its authorized ~~full-time equivalent~~ *(board)* ~~positions~~ *(FTE)* that are funded, in whole or part, with general program revenues not more than ~~one percent~~ *10%* above the level authorized for the board. Under the bill, the board must submit the proposal to the secretaries of administration and employment relations, together with its methodology for accounting for the cost of funding these positions. If the secretaries of administration and employment relations jointly approve the methodology, the positions are authorized.

Could you insert the following language as the second sentence of the provision?

The incremental costs of any such positions created under this authority shall be funded by the University of Wisconsin System from its base budget level during the fiscal biennium in which authorized and thereafter.
