ETF SPECIAL COUNSEL REIMBURSEMENT LANGUAGE

Sec. 40.04(2)(d) is amended to read:

The costs of investing the assets of and legal representation as authorized under s. 40.03(1)(c) for the benefit plans and retirement systems, including all costs due to s. 40.03(1) (n), shall be paid from the appropriation under s. 20.505 (1) (r) and charged directly against the appropriate investment income or reserve accounts of the benefit plan or retirement system receiving the services.

RETIREMENT AND GROUP INSURANCE

This bill provides that the costs of legal representation authorized by the employe trust funds board for the administration of the employe trust fund must be paid from an appropriation to the department of employe trust funds (DETF) for the purposes of the benefit plans administered by DETF.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on retirement systems for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
