Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

~~Under current law, the state superintendent of public instruction (state superintendent) may award grants for peer mentoring and review to a (cooperative educational service agency (CESA) or to a consortium of CESAs and school districts. This bill increases the appropriation for the peer mentoring and review grant program by \$600,000 in each year of the 1999-01 biennium. In addition, the bill creates a grant program under which the state superintendent awards grants to school districts, (CESAs) and other persons for staff development.~~

SECTION 3. 115.406 of the statutes is created to read:

115.406 Grant program for staff development. (1) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (fL), the state superintendent shall award grants for staff development to school districts, cooperative educational service agencies and other persons.

(2) The state superintendent shall promulgate rules to implement and administer this section, including rules concerning eligibility requirements, the amounts of the grants that may be awarded and the uses to which the grants may be put.

SECTION 4. Appropriation changes.

(1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of public instruction under section 20.255 (2) (fk) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is increased by \$600,000 for fiscal year 1999-00 and the dollar amount is increased by \$600,000 for fiscal year 2000-01 to increase funding for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.
