Subject: Need For Additional Appropriations for Correctional Officer Pay Increases

In reality checking my previous assumptions I've just concluded that what I thought I could use existing appropriations to accomplish, in fact, need new one-time appropriations under s.20.865(1). The purpose is Correctional Officer and Related Positions Pay Adjustments and the appropriations, patterned after those Rick created for the Additional Biweekly Payroll. We only need GPR and PR supplemental appropriations based on the known funding sources for these adjustments which occurred earlier this month. The GPR should be annual, with repeal on June 30, 2001 and the PR should be sum sufficient. We are using a supplement approach rather than building the costs in to agency appropriations because it is not feasible to allocate these down to the detail level yet. Therefore, we will make the two agencies (DOC and HFS) whole for the costs as we do via pay plan next biennium.

I'm sorry for this late request, but my re-examination of the statutory language under s.20.865(1)(c), where I had previously placed the GPR, suggests that legislative approval would be needed (JOCER) to release supplements from this source.
