1 **AN ACT ...; relating to:** the budget.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

OCCUPATIONAL REGULATION

This bill requires the department of regulation and licensing (DORL) to prepare proposed legislation that establishes a process for annually evaluating the necessity of at least 25% of the credentialing boards in DORL and eliminating the credentialing boards that are unnecessary. The proposed legislation must also establish credential renewal fees that must be paid every four years rather than every two years as required under current law. DORL must submit the proposed legislation to the governor and the legislature no later than August 1, 2000.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 9142. Nonstatutory provisions; regulation and licensing.**

3 (1) PROPOSED LEGISLATION; CREDENTIALING BOARDS AND CREDENTIAL RENEWAL FEES.

4 The department of regulation and licensing shall prepare proposed legislation that

5 establishes a regular and orderly process for the department to evaluate the

1 continued necessity of at least 25% of the credentialing boards, as defined in section
2 440.01 (2) (bm) of the statutes, on an annual basis and for eliminating the
3 credentialing boards that are determined to be unnecessary. The proposed
4 legislation shall also include provisions for establishing credential renewal fees that
5 must be paid by credential holders every 4 years rather than every 2 years as
6 required under current law. No later than August 1, 2000, the department of
7 regulation and licensing shall submit the proposed legislation in proper form to the
8 legislature in the manner provided under section 13.172 (2) of the statutes and to the
9 governor.
