# Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau EMPLOYMENT

Under current law, the Wisconsin employment relations commission (WERC) must assess and collect fees from parties who request WERC services relating to labor disputes involving fact—finding, mediation or arbitration. This bill requires that WERC assess and collect a fee from any party who requests that WERC assemble a panel of individuals who are not members or employes of WERC to act as an arbitrator to resolve a dispute involving the interpretation or application of a collective bargaining agreement. Fees must be paid at the time of filing the request and any such request may not be considered filed until the date that the fee is paid.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 20.425 (1) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 3 20.425 (1) (h) Collective bargaining training. All moneys received from
- 4 arbitrators and arbitration panel members, and individuals who are interested in

serving in such positions, and from individuals and organizations who participate in other collective bargaining training programs conducted by the commission, and from fees paid under ss. 111.09 (2m), 111.71 (2m) and 111.94 (2m), for the cost of training programs under ss. 111.09 (3), 111.71 (5) and 111.94 (3).

**Section 2.** 111.09 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

111.09 (2m) The commission shall assess and collect a fee from any party who requests that the commission assemble a panel of individuals who are not members or employes of the commission to act as an arbitrator to resolve a dispute involving the interpretation or application of a collective bargaining agreement under s. 111.10. Any fee assessed and collected under this subsection shall be in addition to any fee assessed and collected under sub. (2). The commission shall promulgate rules establishing a schedule of fees to be paid under this subsection. Fees required to be paid under this subsection shall be paid at the time of filing the request and any such request may not be considered filed until the date that the fee is paid. Fees collected under this subsection shall be credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.425 (1) (h).

**SECTION 3.** 111.71 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

111.71 (2m) The commission shall assess and collect a fee from any party who requests that the commission assemble a panel of individuals who are not members or employes of the commission to act as an arbitrator to resolve a dispute involving the interpretation or application of a collective bargaining agreement under s. 111.70 (4) (c) 2. or (cm) 4. Any fee assessed and collected under this subsection shall be in addition to any fee assessed and collected under sub. (2). The commission shall promulgate rules establishing a schedule of fees to be paid under this subsection. Fees required to be paid under this subsection shall be paid at the time of filing the

request and any such request may not be considered filed until the date that the fee is paid. Fees collected under this subsection shall be credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.425 (1) (h).

**SECTION 4.** 111.94 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

111.94 (2m) The commission shall assess and collect a fee from any party who requests that the commission assemble a panel of individuals who are not members or employes of the commission to act as an arbitrator to resolve a dispute involving the interpretation or application of a collective bargaining agreement under s. 111.86. Any fee assessed and collected under this subsection shall be in addition to any fee assessed and collected under sub. (2). The commission shall promulgate rules establishing a schedule of fees to be paid under this subsection. Fees required to be paid under this subsection shall be paid at the time of filing the request and any such request may not be considered filed until the date that the fee is paid. Fees collected under this subsection shall be credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.425 (1) (h).


