#### Huntington's Disease

Motion:

Move to require DHFS to prepare a report on services provided to individuals with Huntington's Disease and to submit the report to the Joint Committee on Finance by January 1, 2000. Specify that the report would include information on: (a) the number of individuals with any type of disability who receive services through the community integration program II (CIP II), the regular community options program (COP-R) and COP-waiver (COP-W) and county revenues in each of the counties within the state; (b) the number of individuals with Huntington's Disease who receive services through the same programs, including both the number and percentage of individuals served in each program; and (c) the types of services including individuals with Huntington's Disease receive under these programs.

Note:

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Huntington's Disease is an inherited, degenerative disease which affects the mind and body. It usually begins during mid-life and is characterized by intellectual decline and irregular and involuntary movement of the limbs or facial muscles. Other symptoms include personality change, memory disturbance, slurred speech, impaired judgement, and psychiatric problems.
