Motion:

Move to permit DHFS to submit a proposal to the Department of Administration that would:
(a) provide additional expenditure and position authority for the DHFS Bureau of Health Care Information to conduct health care data collection activities; and (b) identify potential sources of revenue to support the activities contained in the proposal. Specify that DOA could modify the proposal and, at DOA's option, forward the proposal to the Joint Committee on Finance for its review and approval under a 14-day passive review process.

Note:

This motion would establish a process under which DHFS could, but would not be required to, develop a proposal to conduct health care data collection activities and submit the proposal to DOA. DOA could modify the proposal and forward it the Joint Committee on Finance for its review and approval under a 14-day passive review process.

5 expenditure and position authority, including any proposed modifications of the
6 department of administration. If, within 14 working days after receiving the
7 proposal, the cochairpersons notify the secretary of ~~the department of~~
8 administration that the cochairpersons have scheduled a meeting for the purpose of
9 reviewing the proposal, the department of administration may not approve the
10 proposed expenditure and position authority, including any proposed modifications
11 of the department of administration, except as approved by the committee.”.


