DISTRICT ATTORNEYS

Eliminate Reporting Requirement of County Clerk to District Attorney

Motion:

Move to delete statutory language requiring the county clerk to promptly notify the district attorney of every action or proceeding commenced against the county and of every appeal from the action of the county board of supervisors.

Note:

Prior to January 1, 1990, district attorneys, deputy district attorneys and assistant district attorneys were county employees. Under 1989 Act 31, prosecutors became state employees on January 1, 1990. Section 59.23(2)(i) of the statutes requires the county clerk to promptly notify the district attorney of every action or proceeding commenced against the county and of every appeal from the action of the county board of supervisors. This motion would delete the statutory requirement.

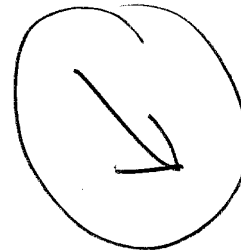

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county clerk is required to notify the district attorney of every action or proceeding commenced against the county and of every appeal from the action of the county board. This bill repeals this requirement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 SECTION 1. 59.23 (2) (i) of the statutes is repealed. "
