Move to require DOT to submit all long-range transportation improvement plans in draft form to the Joint Committee on Finance for review under a 14-day passive review process, prior to the adoption of a final plan. Specify that if the Committee notifies DOT of its intent to schedule a meeting to consider the plan that DOT may not adopt a final plan until the Committee has taken action on the draft plan. Provide that the Committee may either endorse the draft plan or require DOT to reconsider particular elements of the draft plan. 7 facilities, harbors or mass transit systems that covers a time period of more than 6
8 years.

9 (2) If the department proposes to adopt a long-range transportation plan the
10 secretary shall, prior to the department’s adoption of the plan, submit the plan to the
11 joint committee on finance. If the cochairpersons of the committee do not notify the
12 department within 14 working days after the date of the department’s submittal that

1 the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the plan, the
2 department may adopt the plan. If, within 14 working days after the date of the
3 department's submittal, the cochairpersons of the committee notify the department
4 that the committee has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the plan,
5 the department may adopt the plan only upon approval of the committee. If the
6 committee directs the department to reconsider parts of the plan, the department
7 may adopt the plan only after reconsidering the plan, resubmitting a revised plan to
8 the committee and receiving the committee's approval."
