Motion:

Move to create a January 1, 2000, sunset for the current law provisions allowing DNR, with the approval of the Waterways Commission, to pay up to 100% of the eligible costs for the construction of a harbor of refuge on the Lake Superior shoreline.

Note:

Under current law, DNR may provide grants of up to 50% of the costs of developing recreational boating facilities (and up to 60% of the costs if the sponsor conducts a boating safety program), with provisions allowing for an 80% or 90% cost-share for projects of statewide or regional significance. The 1997-99 biennial budget allowed for full funding for a harbor of refuge on Lake Superior. There is no sunset date for the Lake Superior provision in current law.
