NATURAL RESOURCES - WATER QUALITY

Aquaculture Provisions

Motion:

Move to specify that, for the purposes of permitting for enlargement and protection of waterways, that "agricultural use" is defined to include aquaculture.

Also, specify that fish farms may obtain water from lakes, ponds and flowing streams by the use of flumes, pipes, ditches and pumps, but require that the water be discharged back to pond, lake or stream from which it is taken. Require that all flumes, pipes and ditches used to lead water into and from a fish farm be equipped with screens constructed, placed and maintained to prevent the passage of fish to or from the farm.
