Under both of these sections, the executive action en from the base (current law). As a result, unless provided for in the action taken by the Committee's everything in the Governor's bill is removed. The Committee has not yet taken up kinship care and brighter Those issues will be taken up on TANF day. The following changes should be drafted to AB 133. Community Aids Allocation and Funding Limits (LFB paper #541) - This was a modification that requires
a chang statutor	e to the amount of Title IV-B, part 1 that is provided in community aids s. 48.985 (2) and would increase the y allocation for the substance abuse block grant by \$100 so that it is consistent with the funding provided.

Allocation and Funding Limits (DHFS -- Community Aids)

CURRENT LAW

Base funds for community aids includes \$11,318,700 FED from the substance abuse prevention and treatment (SAPT) block grant and \$3,734,000 FED from the child welfare block grant available under Title IV-B of the Social Security Act. Further, DHFS is authorized to distribute no more than \$10,493,900 in 1997-98 and \$10,224,100 in 1998-99 for the substance abuse prevention and treatment (SAPT) block grant as a categorical allocation under community aids. Further, DHFS is authorized to distribute no more than \$3,804,000 in 1997-99 and not more than \$3,734,000 in 1998-99 in the community aids basic county allocation from the state's federal child welfare block grant authorized under Title IV-B, part 1 of the Social Security Act.

Base funding for the community aids SAPT block grant is greater than the authorized statutory allocation because the state's federal SAPT block grant allocation was increased beginning in 1997-98. On April 14, 1998, under a 14-day passive approval process authorized under s. 46.49 (1), the Joint Committee on Finance authorized DHFS to exceed the statutory allocation for the community aids SAPT block grant allocation as a result of the increased federal funding. As a result, in the 1997-99 biennium, counties received a total of \$11,318,700 annually from the community aids SAPT block grant allocation.

GOVERNOR

Require DHFS to distribute through community aids not more than \$11,318,600 in each fiscal year from the federal SAPT block grant and not more than \$3,734,000 from the Title IV-B child welfare block grant. The Governor's recommendations do not modify base funding for the SAPT and child welfare block grant funds budgeted in community aids.

DISCUSSION POINTS

- 1. It is currently estimated that the amount of child welfare block grant funds available for distribution under community aids totals \$3,964,400 PED annually or \$230,400 FED more than currently estimated in the Governor's budget. Further, the amounts budgeted for the community aids SAPT block grant allocation totals \$100 nore than the statutory allocation allows.
- 2. As a result, base funding federal child welfare block grant funds should be increased by \$230,400 FED annually to reflect the current estimate of available federal revenue. Further, the bill should specify that DHFS is authorized to distribute not more than \$3.964.400 annually in community aids from the child welfare block grant and not more than \$11,318,700 annually for the community aids SAPT block grant allocation to reflect the current amount of funding budgeted for that purpose.

MODIFICATION TO BASE

Increase federal funding budgeted for community aids by \$230,400 FED annually and modify current statutory allocations for community aids to reflect that DHFS would be authorized to distribute no more than \$3,964,400 annually in community aids from the child welfare block grant and no more than \$11,318,700 annually for the community aids SAPT block grant allocation.


