48.62 (4) Monthly payments in foster care shall be provided according to the age-related rates specified in this subsection. Beginning on January 1, 1998, the age-related rates are \$289 for children aged 4 and under; \$315 for children aged 5 to 11; \$358 for children aged 12 to 14 and \$374 for children aged 15 to 17. Beginning on January 1, 1999, the age-related rates are: \$299 for children aged 4 and under; \$329 for children aged 5 to 11; \$375 for children aged 12 to 14; and \$387 for children aged 15 to 17. In addition to these grants for basic maintenance, the department shall make supplemental payments for special needs, exceptional circumstances, care in a treatment foster home and initial clothing allowances according to rules promulgated by the department. "
