### Information Technology Investment Fund (ITIF and DOA -- Information Technology)

[LFB 1999-01 Budget Summary: Page 363, #1 and Page 60, #5]

#### CURRENT LAW

The Information Technology Investment Fund (ITIF) is designed to provide grants to state agencies for information technology projects. The fund is administered by the Department of Administration (DOA). Funding of: (a) \$121,300 GPR annually is provided in DOA for administration of the ITIF; and (b) \$914,800 GPR annually is provided for ITIF grants to state agencies. The GPR appropriations for ITIF administration and grants sunset on June 30, 1999.

#### GOVERNOR

Provide \$121,300 SEG annually from the ITIF for administrative costs in DOA. No funding for ITIF grants is proposed in 1999-01. Also, remove base funding of \$914,800 GPR annually for ITIF grants and \$121,300 GPR for ITIF administration.

#### DISCUSSION POINTS

1. Funding for the ITIF is generated from a \$125 annual fee charged vendors who wish to automatically be notified of state bids in particular commodity areas and to have on-line access to bid specifications and vendor information. A lower annual fee of \$65 is charged to minority vendors and work centers for severely handicapped individuals. Further, a \$100 annual subscription fee for each additional location is charged to vendors wishing to receive the electronic subscription service in more than one location.

2. When the ITIF was established in the 1995-97 budget, the expectation was that revenues from these fees would be sufficient to support an information technology grants program

for state agencies as well as the operating costs of the vendor information system (VendorNet). The VendorNet system is used both by vendors interested in providing services and products to the state and by state agencies seeking to identify vendors who provide particular services and products.

3. Expenditures under the new fund first occurred in 1996-97 when ITIF grant and administrative expenditures from the fund of \$3,828,800 SEG were made based on projected initial revenues of \$4.3 million. However, this level of revenues never materialized. Consequently, for that year, DOA made an interfund revenue transfer of \$3,957,700 to the ITIF from its telecommunications appropriation to provide sufficient revenues to support these expenditures. The transfer from the telecommunication appropriation is to be repaid from vendor fee revenues over time.

4. In the 1997-99 budget, because of continued insufficient revenues in the fund and significantly reduced estimates of future revenues (reestimated to be about \$240,000 annually), the Legislature created statutory language specifying that no new ITIF grants could be made from the ITIF until the fund reached a positive cash balance. In order to finance previously awarded ITIF grants and administrative costs, GPR funding was provided for 1997-98 and 1998-99.

5. In 1997-98, the vendor fee generated revenues of \$162,300 for the fund. Further, an additional \$23,500 for the fund was generated from interest on the fund balance. Since the fund had an opening balance of \$265,200 in that year, the ITIF was able to make a \$400,000 repayment to the telecommunications appropriation. At the end of 1997-98, the fund had a closing balance of \$109,000, and owed the telecommunications appropriation a total of \$3,557,700.

6. Based on current projected new revenues, it is estimated that the ITIF will receive new revenues of approximately \$172,200 in 1998-99. Since there is no repayment schedule for the ITIF loan from the telecommunications appropriation, DOA can repay these costs as revenues become available. DOA expects to make a repayment of at least \$250,000 in 1998-99, which would leave an ending 1998-99 fund balance of about \$31,200. Under this scenario, the balance owed to the telecommunications appropriation would be reduced to \$3,307,700 at the end of 1998-99.

7. The Governor's budget deletes GPR funding for the ITIF because the GPR appropriations for administration and grants sunset on June 30, 1999. In addition, the Governor recommends that the existing appropriation for ITIF administrative costs in DOA be utilized for these costs beginning in 1999-00. Under AB 133, \$121,300 SEG annually is provided for administrative costs (maintenance of the vendor database and the VendorNet web site).

8. Based on current estimated annual revenues of \$164,000 and annual administrative costs of \$121,300, the ITIF would only be able to repay the telecommunication appropriation approximately \$43,000 per year. At this rate of repayment, the loan would not be repaid for another 77 years.

9. Given that lengthy repayment obligation projection and the modest level of revenues currently generated by the vendor fee, the ability of the ITIF to support a state agency information

technology initiatives grant program could be called into question. Further, in the absence of an active ITIF grant program, state agencies have developed and implemented biennial IT budget plans funded through the normal budget process. The Committee could, therefore, repeal the ITIF grant program, but retain the SEG fund for the vendor fees, operation of the VendorNet program and repayment of the remaining loan balance. The fund could be renamed the VendorNet Fund to reflect its revised purpose. Under this alternative, vendor fees would continue to support the administrative aspects of VendorNet and to repay the telecommunication appropriation loan. Maintaining a SEG fund would allow interest to be paid on any balance in the appropriation.

10. In 1997-98, actual expenditures for ITIF administrative costs were \$90,200. Projected costs for 1998-99 are estimated to be about the same. Based on these lower level of actual expenditures for administrative activities, the Committee could reduce the administrative costs recommended by the Governor by \$31,100 to provide a budgeted level of \$90,200 SEG annually for the next biennium.

11. Since the GPR appropriations for the ITIF sunset on June 30, 1999, if the Committee does not provide SEG funding for ITIF administration, there would not be any monies available to operate the VendorNet system or collect the fees.

#### ALTERNATIVES

1. Approve the Governor's recommendation to provide \$121,300 SEG annually from the ITIF for administrative costs in DOA and remove base funding of \$914,800 GPR annually for ITIF grants and \$121,300 GPR for ITIF administration.

2. Modify the Governor's recommendation to reduce funding for ITIF administration by \$31,100 SEG annually.

3. In addition to Alternative 1 or 2, repeal the information technology investment fund grant program to state agencies for information technology initiatives and the associated appropriations for distribution of such grant funds.
