Continuing Eligibility for Current Milwaukee Parental Choice Program Pupils

[LFB Paper #786]

Motion:

Move to provide that once a pupil qualifies for the Milwaukee parental choice program (MPCP), he or she would continue to be eligible for the program until graduation from high school, regardless of family income level.

Note:

Under current law, a pupil is eligible for the MPC program if he or she is a member of a family that has a total family income that does not exceed an amount equal to 1.75 times the poverty level determined in accordance with criteria established by the Director of the Federal Office of Management and Budget.

Under this motion, a pupil would continue to be eligible for the MPC program until graduation from high school, even if his or her family income increases to an amount above 1.75 times the relevant poverty level.


