### NATURAL RESOURCES -- FISH AND WILDLIFE

Endangered Resources Plate for Damage Payments

Motion:

Move to specify that 3% of the amount generated by the endangered resources plate in each fiscal year be allocated for wildlife damage control and payments of claims for damage associated with endangered or threatened species. Specify that the total amount from the endangered resources plate and tax check-off used for wildlife damage purposes may not exceed \$100,000.

Note:

Under current law, 3% of the amount generated by the endangered resources tax check-off, not to exceed \$100,000, is allocated for wildlife damage control and payments of claims for damage associated with endangered or threatened species. In 1997-98, the 3% allotment was \$16,100 and \$16,800 was paid in damage claims. Under this motion, revenue from the endangered resources plate would be allocated to this purpose. In 1997-98, this would have generated an additional \$18,700 for these payments.


