Motion:

Move to provide \$112,000 in general obligation bonding for construction of a public interpretive center at the Mead Wildlife Area in Portage, Marathon and Wood Counties. Specify that expenditures from the bonding authorization be made in a manner that, for every \$2 received by DNR from private grants, gifts or bequests for the project, \$3 be expended from the appropriation. Also, provide \$12,000 GPR in 1999-00 and \$16,000 GPR in 2000-01 and 0.5 GPR position at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point for educational and informational activities at the Center.
