Becoming an Outdoors-Woman Statewide Coordinator

Motion:

Move to provide \$33,000 SEG in 1999-00 and \$44,000 SEG in 2000-01 (from the fish and wildlife account) of the conservation fund to contract for a coordinator position for the *an* Becoming and Outdoors-Woman (BOW) program. Further, provide \$33,000 PR in 1999-00 and \$44,000 PR in 2000-01 and 1.0 PR position annually at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point for this purpose. Also, specify that, in order to receive the conservation fund SEG, the BOW program must first demonstrate that it has received an equal amount of outside funding from federal funds, gifts and grants, program revenue or in-kind support.

Note:

The BOW program provides educational opportunities for learning skills for hunting, fishing, camping, canoeing and other outdoor recreational opportunities. Over 40 states and nine Canadian provinces administer some form of this program. While the target audience for the program is women, men may also attend the workshops. Currently, a limited term employe at UW Stevens Point funded from grants and program revenue coordinates the program.

6 **29.598 Outdoors skills training.** (1) [✓]PROGRAM COORDINATION. The
7 department[✓] and the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin[✓] System shall
8 enter into an agreement with an established national organization that provides
9 training to persons who are interested in learning about the outdoor skills needed
10 by women to hunt, fish, camp, canoe and undertake other outdoor recreational
11 activities in order to provide that type of training to interested persons.

12 (2) MATCH.[✓] No moneys may be transferred from the appropriation account
13 under s. 20.370 (1) (mu) to pay for the costs associated with the agreement under sub.
14 (1),[✓] unless the organization described in sub. (1) provides a matching contribution
15 to the department at a ratio of one-to-one. The matching contribution may be in the
16 form of money or in-kind[✓] goods or services."

Please note that under s. 29.598 (2), as created in this draft, the match required by the national outdoors skills training organization may be in the form of money or in-kind goods or services. The motion on which this draft is based specified that the match must be from federal funds, gifts and grants, program revenue or in-kind support. Because I was uncertain about what types of federal funds, gifts and grants and program revenue would satisfy the match requirement, I did not specify in the draft that the match must come from these specific sources. If the language in the draft is not consistent with the intent of the motion, please let me know and I will redraft accordingly.
