Metallic Mining Local Agreements

Motion:

Move to require an agreement between a local governmental unit and the operator of a proposed mine to provide that the agreement is subject to amendment at the request of either party if additional information relevant to the issues addressed in the agreement is obtained after the agreement takes effect but before the hearing held by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) on whether to issue a permit for the mine. Further, apply this provision to an agreement between a local governmental unit and the operator of a proposed mine that takes effect before enactment of the budget and DNR has not issued or denied the permit for the proposed mine.

Note:

This motion incorporates the provision of LRB 2725/1. Current law authorizes a local governmental unit that requires an approval or permit for a proposed metallic mineral mine to enter into an agreement with the operator of the mine. The agreement must include various provisions, including a provision for the amendment of the agreement.

## 1997 BILL

AN ACT to amend 293.41 (2) (g); and to create 293.41 (6) and 293.49 (2) (g) of the statutes; relating to: required conditions in local agreements related to mining, reopening local agreements related to mining and denial of a mining permit by the department of natural resources.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes a local governmental unit that requires an approval or permit for a proposed metallic mineral mine to enter into an agreement with the operator of the mine. The agreement must include various provisions, including a provision for the amendment of the agreement.

This bill requires an agreement between a local governmental unit and the operator of a proposed mine to provide that the agreement is subject to amendment at the request of either party if additional information relevant to the issues addressed in the agreement is obtained after the agreement takes effect but before the hearing held by the department of natural resources (DNR) on whether to issue a permit for the mine. The bill also provides that if an agreement between a local governmental unit and the operator of a proposed mine takes effect before this bill becomes law and DNR has not issued or denied the permit for the proposed mine before this bill becomes law, the local governmental unit may ask the operator to engage in negotiations regarding an amendment to the agreement based on additional information that is relevant to the issues addressed in the agreement and
