Unclassified Division Administrators

Motion:

Move to create 5.0 unclassified division administrator positions in the Department of Corrections beginning in 1999-00. Delete 5.0 classified division administrator positions in 1999-00.

Note:

This motion converts the division administrator positions in the Department of Corrections from classified status to unclassified status. As unclassified employees, division administrators would be appointed and dismissed at the discretion of the Secretary of the Department of Corrections. Unclassified division administrator positions would be assigned to an executive salary group by the Department of Employment Relations, receive increased fringe benefits (approximately \$17,100 annually for the five positions based on current salaries), receive additional vacation and leave privileges, have a higher formula factor (from 1.6 to 2.0) used for determining Wisconsin retirement system formula benefits and could retire with full benefits at age 62 rather than age 65. Current employees could be appointed to the unclassified positions. Current employees would retain civil service status and as a result have the ability to be placed in other classified positions in Corrections, if not retained as division administrators.
