BadgerCare Outreach

Motion:

Move to direct DFHS to coordinate a BadgerCare outreach mailing targeted to children enrolled in the national school lunch program with DPI and to complete this mailing October 1, 1999.

Note:

There are approximately 226,300 students in the state who are receiving free and reduced lunches under the national school lunch program. In order to be eligible for the program, children must live in families with income below 185% of the federal poverty level. The income eligibility threshold for BadgerCare is 185% of the FPL. Therefore, it is likely that most children participating in the National School Lunch program would be eligible for BadgerCare.

BadgerCare outreach expenditures are eligible for a 71% federal match.
