Joint Finance took action yesterday on Legislative Fiscal Bureau Paper 195, relating to the computer-based land information initiative. [See also LRB 1254/5.] I am assuming that you have the paper [if not, it is available at the Legislative Fiscal Bureau web page].

JFC adopted alternatives A4, B2, C3 and C4. Thus, it seems that the following will be required:

1. Push back ~~the~~ repeal of the Land Information Board under s. 16.967 and the repeal of the land records modernization funding under s. 59.72 until 9-1-05. This will undoubtedly impact a number of other sections, too, most notably ss. 16.966 and 16.968 as well as the various current law appropriations: ss. 20.505(l)(ie), (ig) & (lj). There are undoubtedly other current law hits which you'll have to find by a computer search. We do NOT want to affect the current 9-1-03 repeal of the Land Council and its related appropriation.

2. Delete the authority of DOA (under bill sections 111 to 113) to develop and maintain a computer-based land info system. The associated appropriation structure for this activity must also be deleted

3. Instead, grant the Land Information Board the authority to undertake soil survey and soil mapping activities, and make it clear that the Board may contract for these services and may expend funds for these activities – it will in fact be using a federal agency to do this work for them. They also need the authority to contract with the Bd. of Commissioners for soil mapping and surveying on trust lands.

4. Also, rather than establishing a parallel soil survey/mapping appropriation structure similar to the one in the bill for the computer-based land information system, it seems to me that it will probably be easier to amend the Board's current GPO appropriation purpose to permit it to fund the soil survey and mapping activities from that appropriation account. [Do you agree?] Further, give the Board the authority to assess state agencies for the soil survey and mapping activities [with the funds going into proposed s. 20.505(1)(kt), as amended]. Put a 9-1-05 repeal on this appropriation.

- ✓ 3. Also retain s. 20.505(1)(k) but change the title to read: Land Information board; soil surveys and mapping. You will also need to modify the appropriation purpose to reflect this. Is a reference to this appropriation needed under s. 16.967(11)? I am inclined to think not, if we reference s. 16.967(11) under the appn purpose. I would prefer the latter. Changes 2 & 3 will probably impact ss. 7 & 8 of the draft.
- ✓ 4. The deletion of s. 20.505(1)(k) should stand as you have it in 504/1.
