- 56. LFB Paper #1109. Alternative 4. Maintain current law (eliminate funding for workforce mentors).
- 57. LFB Paper #1110. Alternative B2. Maintain current law by providing \$52,000 GPR annually in the Department of Employe Relations for one state recruiter position and deleting \$52,000 of monies to be allocated the transfer of federal TANF monies.
- 58. LFB Paper #1110. Modify the Governor's proposal relating to funding for Head Start by providing \$3,712,500 GPR annually and decreasing TANF funding by \$6,187,500 PR annually in the Department of Public Instruction for the program. This would provide annual funding of \$3,712,500 GPR and \$3,712,500 PR for the Head Start program.
