**Wisconsin Conservation Corps -- Education Voucher  
[Paper #1066]**

**Motion:**

Move to permit corps enrollees who successfully complete six months of service to be eligible to receive an education voucher while they are still employed by the Wisconsin Conservation Corps. Provide that if an enrollee elects to receive a tuition voucher while still employed, the election would continue after the enrollee terminates employment.

**Note:**

Corps enrollees who successfully complete six months to one year of service in the Wisconsin Conservation Corps (WCC) and terminate employment are eligible to receive either a cash bonus of \$500 or an education voucher that is worth at least \$1,000, but not more than \$2,600 (\$2,800 under the bill). This motion would permit enrollees who complete six months of service to receive an education voucher while they continue to be employed by the WCC.
