Hi Bob,

Thanks for the three DVA language drafts on eliminating the statutory caps and the approps change. I don't believe I sent you an email regarding DVA changes, which means you are keeping track of what is going on. Very impressive and I appreciate it. I apologize for not getting this email to you immediately, but I was swamped. Below are the changes that need to be done, including one for Military Affairs because of the TANF decision. I marked the ones I just received.

DVA

20.866 (2) (2N)

1. Home Loan Bonding. (Paper 1015) I am not sure you are responsible for the number that is put in the statutes, but the cap on bonding needs to be raised. The total bonding available should be \$213,000,000 and the cap should be increased from \$1,807,500,000 to \$2,020,500,000.

2. Veterans Assistance Program (Paper 1025) Make the Federal per diem appropriation an annual sum certain appropriation rather than a continuing appropriation. [20.485.(2)(x)]. **Received**

3. Health Care Aid Grants - (Paper 1029) Delete the \$1.2 million statutory cap proposed by the Governor. Provide session language requiring DVA to conduct a thorough review of the HCAG program and examine program modifications which could be made to restrain growth in expenditures of the program, and submit by Dec. 31, 1999 a report to the Committee reporting on its review and including any program changes which the Department believes should be made. **Received**

4. Retraining Grants - (Paper 1030) Eliminate the statutory cap proposed by the Governor. **Received**

5. WWII Memorial - (Motion 1103) A motion was passed to incorporate the appropriations created in Wisconsin Act 2 into the budget and include session law so that the appropriations are not double counted.

DMA

1. Badger Challenge (Paper 1114 and Motion 1112 # 62) As part of the deal on TANF funding, the JFC funded the Badger Challenge program at 10% TANF the first year and 25% TANF the second year. The Gov. funded the Badger Challenge program 100% TANF in both years. Therefore we have to modify the Governor's proposed language to direct DMA to recruit TANF eligible classes that meet the percentages instead of requiring the whole class to be TANF eligible.
