Dental Services

Motion:

Move to require the Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) to provide funding to the Marquette University School of Dentistry (MUSOD) to increase access to dental care through the provision of dental services and student education by MUSOD students and faculty for correctional centers in Milwaukee County, in clinics in the City of Milwaukee and in underserved areas and populations as determined by the DHFS and MUSOD.

Note:

- Base level
Under current law, \$2,860,500 GPR annually is provided from DHFS to MUSOD to provide dental services to low-income individuals at health clinics in the City of Milwaukee, Waushara County, Monroe County and in correctional centers in Milwaukee County. MUSOD provides dental services to low-income individuals through partnerships with five local health clinics. Three of these of clinics are in the City of Milwaukee: Main Clinic at MUSOD, the Johnston Community Health Center and the Isaac Coggs Community Health Center. The two other clinics are located in the rural areas of ~~Wild Rose~~ *Wautoma* (Waushara County) and Cashton (Monroe County).

This motion would modify current law to permit MUSOD to provide dental services in underserved areas as determined by DHFS and MUSOD, rather than just Waushara County and Monroe County. MUSOD would still be required to provide dental services in clinics in the City of Milwaukee. In addition, the motion would clarify that MUSOD would provide dental service for correction inmates that could be treated at the dental school's campus location, rather than in correction centers. In addition, the motion would specify that the funding would be used for the education of dental students through the provision of these dental services by students and faculty.

MARQUETTE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY
Proposed Amendment 6/7/99

Description: To amend the current statutory language regarding the geographic areas in which Marquette University School of Dentistry (MUSOD) is permitted to use state funds to provide oral health care services, and to clarify the educational purpose associated with this funding.

Rationale for Proposed Statutory Change: The current statutory language limits the dental school's flexibility to respond to the existing dental access problems in certain areas of the State of Wisconsin, particularly in rural communities. In addition, this change will clarify the original intent of this funding which is to provide educational opportunities for dental students to provide oral health care services to underserved populations in the State of Wisconsin. This funding has always had a dual purpose: 1) to educate and train dentists to treat patients in underserved areas, and 2) to provide dental services in those communities. This clarification will help ensure that the dual purpose of MUSOD's participation in clinical settings is understood. Finally, this language change will clarify that MUSOD will provide dental services for corrections inmates residing at pre-release centers in Milwaukee County. These pre-release residents are treated at the dental school's campus location. MUSOD does not have the capacity to provide dental services on-site at correctional centers. In addition, these funds are part of the DHFS budget, not the Department of Corrections budget.

This statutory language change will not require any change in GPR funding for MUSOD.

The current statutory language is as follows:

"250.10 Grant for dental services. From the appropriation under s.20.435 (5)(de), the department shall provide funding in each fiscal year to the Marquette University School of Dentistry for the provision of dental services by the Marquette University School of Dentistry in Waushara County and Monroe County, in correctional centers in Milwaukee County and in clinics in the city of Milwaukee."

The proposed change in statutory language is as follows:

"250.10 Grant for dental services. From the appropriation under s.20.435 (5)(de), the department shall provide funding in each fiscal year to the Marquette University School of Dentistry to increase access to dental care through the provision of dental services and student education by the Marquette University School of Dentistry students and faculty for correctional centers in Milwaukee County, in clinics in the city of Milwaukee, and in underserved areas and populations as determined by the department and Marquette University School of Dentistry."

Tricia Collins:

I did not specify that the funding would be used “for the education of dental students through the provision” of services because the funding is for the provision of services by the students. It is always a university’s purpose to educate its students and it seems unnecessary to include such a provision here. Presumably, the mere provision of the services educates the students. Additionally, if any students failed to become educated through the provision of the dental services, under the language proposed, the purpose of the funding would not be met and the funding could be jeopardized.
