#### Do-Not-Resuscitate Bracelets

#### Motion:

Move to modify the bill as follows: (a) specify that after a patient provides all of the information required under current law for a do-not-resuscitate order, the attending physician or the person directed by the attending physician would document in a patient's medical record the medical condition that qualifies the patient for a do-not-resuscitate order, would make the order in writing and would do one of the following, as requested by the patient: (a) affix to the wrist of the patient a do-not-resuscitate bracelet that meets the uniform standard established by DHFS by rule; or (b) provide an order form from a commercial vendor approved by the Department to permit the patient to order a do-not-resuscitate bracelet from the commercial vendor. Specify that DHFS may approve a do-not-resuscitate bracelet developed and distributed by a commercial vendor if the bracelet contains an emblem that displays an internationally recognized medical symbol on the front and the words "Wisconsin Do-Not-Resuscitate-EMS" and the qualified patient's first and last name on the back. Prohibit DHFS from approving a do-not-resuscitate bracelet developed and distributed by a commercial vendor if the vendor does not require a doctor's order for the bracelet prior to distributing it to the patient.



AN ACT to renumber and amend 154.19 (2) (b) and 154.27; to amend 154.17

(1), 154.29 (1) and 154.29 (2); and to create 154.19 (2) (b) 2. and 154.27 (2) of

the statutes; relating to: do-not-resuscitate and medical condition alert

bracelets.

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## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person who is at least 18 years old and who has a terminal or very severe medical condition (qualified patient) may request from a physician a do-not-resuscitate order. If the order is issued, the physician, or someone directed by the physician, affixes on the qualified patient's wrist a do-not-resuscitate bracelet designed by the department of health and family services (DHFS) that alerts medical technicians, first responders and emergency health care facility personnel not to administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation on the patient in the event of cardiag or respiratory failure.

This bill allows a qualified patient who requests a do-not-resuscitate order to request that the physician, or person directed by the physician, affix a do-not-resuscitate bracelet designed by DHFS to his or her wrist or provide an order form to permit the patient to order a bracelet developed and issued by an approved commercial vendor.

SECTION 10 154 17(1)

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SECTION 1. 154.17 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

154.17 (1) "Do-not-resuscitate bracelet" means a standardized identification bracelet of uniform size, color, and design, that meets the specifications established under s. 154.27 (1), or that is approved by the department under s. 154.27 (2), that bears the inscription "Do Not Resuscitate" and signifies that the wearer is a qualified patient who has obtained a do-not-resuscitate order and that the order has not been revoked.

**SECTION 2.** 154.19 (2) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 154.19 (2) (b) (intro.) and amended to read:

154.19 (2) (b) (intro.) After providing the information under par. under s. 154.21 of a do-not-resuscitate order or any responsible person who
withholds personal knowledge of a revocation under s. 154.21 shall be fined not more
than \$10,000 or imprisoned for not more than 10 years or both.
