Motion:

Move to provide \$00,000 SEC - 1991-00 (friendly amendment)


Move to provide \$96,000 SEG annually in a new, biennial appropriation for making grants for the construction or rehabilitation of passenger railroad stations and require DOT to administer a passenger railroad station grant program. Specify that local governments or private entities may receive grants under the program for making improvements along existing or proposed passenger rail routes, and that a grant may not exceed: (a) one-third of the total cost of a project; and (b) \$60,000. Create a SEG-L appropriation to reflect the local match provided by grant recipients and provide \$180,000 SEG-L annually in this appropriation. Specify that the governing body of a local government that applies for a grant under the program must pass a resolution supporting the project prior to the approval of the grant. Require DOT to promulgate rules for administering the grant program.

Note:

This motion would create a grant program for the construction or rehabilitation of passenger railroad stations along existing or proposed passenger rail routes. The amount of a grant could not exceed one-third of the total project cost and could not exceed \$60,000.

Here is the language from Jim Thiel on design-build:

"SECTION XXXXXX. Notwithstanding sec. 84.11, Stats. (1991- 92) or secs. 84.01(13), 84.06(2) and 84.11, Stats., (1997-98) or any other statute, the department of transportation may use the design-build concept and enter into a design-build contract for one high cost local bridge for which an agreement apportioning costs has been executed by all participating agencies prior to July 1, 1993 under Section TRANS 215.08(2), Wis. Admin. Code, in any county having a population of 500,000 or more. The design-build process and project must also receive the specific approval of the federal government pursuant to federal Special Experimental Project No. 14, Innovative Contracting Practices, and SECTION 1307(e)(2) of Public Law 105-178. For purposes of this provision, "designbuild" means a method of construction under which the engineering, design and construction are provided by a single entity through a competitive selection process that utilizes, at a minimum, qualifications, quality, time of completion and cost as award criteria. The design-build contract shall be entered into by the department and approved by the Governor. The contract shall incorporate prevailing wage rates under sec. 103.50, Stats., and be subject to public works lien and performance/and payment bond requirements under secs. 779.14 and 779.15, Stats. The contract may contain disadvantaged business enterprise participation provisions consistent with 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 26. To be eligible to participate in the competitive selection process, entities seeking the contract must be prequalified as a contractor and design consultant by the department. The department shall submit a report to the Legislature on the effectiveness of design-build contracting procedures not later than 5 years after the date of enactment of this Act."
