Summary

Currently, the Division of Emergency Government within the Department of Military Affairs has contracts with eight regional teams to respond to any Level A hazardous materials release - these are defined as the release of a hazardous substance that necessitates the highest level of protective equipment. An adjusted base level of \$1,400,000 GPR annually is provided to fund these contracts.

The Joint Committee on Finance approved the Governor's recommendation to provide an additional \$177,400 GPR in 1999 - 00 to allow extension of existing contracts with five Level A hazardous materials response teams until June 30, 2000, so that all eight existing contracts expire at the same time.

This amendment requires the Division of Emergency Management to contract with a ninth Level A Hazardous Materials team in the La Crosse area beginning after the 2000 - 01 contracts expire.
