Summary

The Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) has requested the Department of Employment Relations to do a survey of DVA staff who process and administer veteran loan and grant applications. DVA believes these positions are underclassified compared to comparable positions in other agencies. It is likely that, as a result of the survey, most of the affected DVA staff would receive pay increases. The survey is expected to be completed by early next fiscal year.

This amendment provides \$159,600 SEG in 1999-00 and \$164,400 SEG in 2000-01 to cover any DVA salary and fringe benefit costs resulting from the findings of the staff pay survey.

Fiscal Impact

This amendment calls for a total of \$324,000 in SEG funding in 1999 - 01. Specify the funds be set aside in the Joint Finance Committee's supplemental appropriation for DVA to request release of the funds through the s.13.10.

Statement of Intent

Department of Veterans Affairs. This amendment calls for a total of \$324,000 in SEG funding in 1999 - 01 to cover any salary and fringe benefit costs for DVA loan processors resulting from the findings of a staff pay survey

3 after the date of the department's submittal, the cochairpersons of the committee
4 notify the secretary of the department that the committee intends to schedule a
5 meeting to review the request, the appropriation account shall be supplemented only
6 as approved by the committee. Notwithstanding section 13.101 (3) of the statutes,
7 the committee is not required to find that an emergency exists.”
