Summary: Provision #1

Tuition Revenue Expenditure Authority (UW System)

The motion would restore the Governor's proposal relating to tuition flexibility but would tie WHEG grants for undergraduates enrolled at UW campuses to tuition increases.

UW Madison Initiative

The motion restores the Governor's proposal relating to the UW Madison Initiative, which would have students and taxpayers paying equally for tuition. The JFC action would result in taxpayers paying more of the cost of tuition by eliminating \$6.9 million from increased tuition.

GPR Position Authority

The motion would approve the Governor's recommendation to permit the Board of Regents to request approval from the Secretaries of DOA and DER in the 1999-01 biennium, to increase the number of positions that are funded in whole or in part with GPR by 1% above the base level.

Specify that savings generated through the inclusion of 1999 Assembly 322 in the amendment would be used to increase funding for Wisconsin Higher Education Grants (WHEG) and Tuition Grants (TG). The motion utilizes the \$1,091,800 (GPR) saving to restore \$397,415 in funding over the biennium for WHEG grants to UW students, \$270,766 in funding to WHEG grants for WTCS students, and \$423,618 in funding for TG-eligible students.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 40.41 (6) (b); and **to create** 40.41 (6) (c) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** social security coverage for students employed at public schools,
3 colleges and universities.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, with certain exceptions, public employers are required to provide social security coverage to all of their employees. One of the exceptions to this social security coverage requirement involves students. Currently, public employers are not required to provide social security coverage to students if their employment is in a position that does not normally require actual performance of duty for at least 600 hours in each calendar year.

On October 21, 1998, Congress enacted P.L. 105-277, which provides a limited window of opportunity for states to modify their existing social security coverage agreements with the federal government to exclude from social security coverage services performed by students employed by the public school, college or university where they are enrolled and regularly attending classes. In order to qualify for this provision, a state must enact legislation before July 1, 2000, to provide for the exclusion from social security coverage for these students.

This bill creates this legislation. Under the bill, social security coverage is not provided for services performed in the employ of a school, college or university, if the service is performed by a student who is enrolled and regularly attending classes at the school, college or university.
