Summary

Under current law, the Department of Administration operates the state central fleet through the Bureau of Transportation in the Division of State Agency Services. The state central fleet currently includes about 2,400 cars or light trucks. The Departments of Transportation and Natural Resources and the UW-Madison also operate vehicle fleets. The DOT fleet consists of approximately 1,300 vehicles, the DNR fleet has about 1,500 vehicles and the UW-Madison fleet consists of approximately 750 vehicles. These separate agency fleets consists of cars, vans and light and heavy trucks. In addition, some other agencies, such as the Departments of Corrections and Health and Family Services and other UW campuses also own their own fleets, but also use the DOA central fleet.

The Governor's budget creates session law language to require DOA to submit to the Co-chairs of Joint Finance Committee (JFC), for approval by the Committee, two implementation plans for consolidating certain state vehicle fleet management activities. It provides that the first implementation plan would be due at the fourth quarterly meeting in CY 1999 (December, 1999) of the Committee under section 13.10, and would be an implementation plan for the consolidation of DNR vehicle fleet operations with corresponding DOA operations. It also provides that the second implementation plan would be due at the third quarterly s. 13.10 Committee meeting in CY 2000 (September, 2000) and would be an implementation plan for the consolidation of the DOT and UW-Madison vehicle fleet operations with corresponding DOA operations. The Governor's budget includes language specifying that the Committee may disapprove, approve with modification, or approve one or both implementation plans and that if approved, DOA is authorized to implement the plans on the date specified in the plans.

The JFC budget deleted the Governor's proposal and instead included session law language directing DOA to conduct a study of the possible consolidation of these three separate agency fleets (DOT, DNR, and UW-Madison) or other changes in fleet operations, including estimating possible savings from such consolidation and submitting the results of the study and suggested legislation to the Joint Committee on Finance upon completion of the study. The JFC budget also included a requirement that the UW Board of Regents direct the UW-Madison administration to cooperate with DOA in conducting the study.

This motion deletes the above JFC action and restores the Governor's provisions.

Fiscal Impact

According the LFB, this motion would have no fiscal impact.

Statement of Intent

DOA. The motion restores the Governor's proposal to require DOA to submit to the Co-chairs of Joint Finance Committee (JFC), for approval by the Committee, two implementation plans for consolidating certain state vehicle fleet management activities.

This bill directs the department of administration (DOA) to submit for consideration of the joint committee on finance (JCF) at its fourth quarterly meeting under s. 13.10, stats., in 1999 an implementation plan for consolidating the vehicle fleet management functions of the department of natural resources (DNR) with the corresponding functions of DOA. The bill also directs DOA to submit for consideration of JCF at its third quarterly meeting under s. 13.10, stats., in the year 2000 an implementation plan for consolidating the vehicle fleet management functions of the department of transportation (DOT) and the University of Wisconsin-Madison (UW-Madison) with the corresponding functions of DOA. Assets and liabilities, tangible personal property, full-time equivalent positions, incumbent employes, contracts, rules, orders and pending matters may be transferred to DOA under the plans. The bill permits JCF to approve or to modify and approve the plans. If JCF approves a plan, with or without modifications, DOA may implement that plan. If JCF does not approve any plan, DOA may not implement that plan.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 **SECTION 9158. Nonstatutory provisions; other.**

2 (1) CONSOLIDATION OF STATE VEHICLE FLEET OPERATIONS.

20 functions. The plan shall include identification of the numbers, revenue sources and

5 functions. Employes transferred under the plan have all the rights and the same

9 so transferred who has attained permanent status in class is required to serve a

13 effect on the effective date of this subdivision. If the transfer occurs, the department
14 shall carry out any obligations under such a contract until modified or rescinded by
15 the department to the extent allowed under the contract.

16 6. Transfer to the department of any rules promulgated or orders issued by the
17 department of natural resources relating to its vehicle fleet management functions
18 which are in effect on the effective date of the plan. If the transfer occurs, any such
19 rules shall remain in effect until their specified expiration dates or until amended
20 or repealed by the department, and any such orders shall remain in effect until their
21 specified expiration dates or until modified or rescinded by the department.

22 7. Transfer to the department of any matter pending with the department of
23 natural resources relating to its vehicle fleet management functions. If the transfer
24 occurs, all materials submitted to or actions taken by the department of natural

1 resources with respect to the pending matter are considered as having been
2 submitted to or taken by the department.

3 (d) The department shall submit to the cochairpersons of the joint committee
4 on finance for consideration at the 3rd quarterly meeting of the committee under
5 section 13.10 of the statutes in the year 2000 an implementation plan for
6 consolidating the vehicle fleet management functions of the department of
7 transportation and the University of Wisconsin-Madison with the corresponding
8 functions of the department.

9 (e) The plan submitted under paragraph (d) may include provision for any of
10 the following on the effective date specified in the plan:

11 1. Transfer of the assets and liabilities of the department of transportation and
12 the University of Wisconsin-Madison relating to their vehicle fleet management
13 functions to the department.

1 to vehicle fleet management functions. Employees transferred under the plan have
2 all the rights and the same status under subchapter V of chapter 111 and chapter 230
3 of the statutes that they enjoyed at the department of transportation or the
4 University of Wisconsin-Madison immediately before the transfer. Notwithstanding
5 section 230.08 (4) of the statutes, no employee so transferred who has attained
6 permanent status in class is required to serve a probationary period.

7 5. Transfer to the department of the contracts entered into by the department
8 of transportation and the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System
9 relating to the vehicle fleet management functions of the department of
10 transportation and the University of Wisconsin-Madison which are in effect on the
11 effective date of this subdivision. If the transfer occurs, the department shall carry
12 out any obligations under such a contract until modified or rescinded by the
13 department to the extent allowed under the contract.

14 6. Transfer to the department of any rules promulgated or orders issued by the
15 department of transportation or the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin
16 System relating to the vehicle fleet management functions of the department of
17 transportation or the University of Wisconsin-Madison which are in effect on the
18 effective date of the plan. If the transfer occurs, any such rules shall remain in effect
19 until their specified expiration dates or until amended or repealed by the
20 department, and any such orders shall remain in effect until their specified
21 expiration dates or until modified or rescinded by the department.

22 7. Transfer to the department of any matter pending with the department of
23 transportation or the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System relating
24 to the vehicle fleet management functions of the department of transportation or the
25 University of Wisconsin-Madison. If the transfer occurs, all materials submitted to

1 or actions taken by the department of transportation or the board of regents of the
2 University of Wisconsin System with respect to the pending matter are considered
3 as having been submitted to or taken by the department.

4 (f) The joint committee on finance may approve or modify and approve the plans
5 submitted under paragraphs (b) and (d). If the committee approves a plan, with or
6 without modifications, the department may implement the plan on the effective date
7 of the plan as specified in the plan. If the committee does not approve either plan, the
8 department shall not implement that plan.

9 (g) Notwithstanding section 16.42 of the statutes, the departments of natural
10 resources and transportation and the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin
11 System shall submit information under section 16.42 of the statutes for purposes of
12 the 2001-2003 biennial budget bill reflecting any savings incurred from
13 consolidation of vehicle fleet management functions as the result of implementation


