Summary

1995 Wisconsin Act 27 directed the State Auditor to perform county and municipal best practices reviews. These are intended to examine procedures used by counties and municipalities to deliver and to identify and recommend practices which save money or provide more effective service delivery. The State Auditor appoints an advisory council consisting of members nominated by the Wisconsin Counties Association, Alliance of Cities, League of Municipalities and Towns Association for assistance in the selection of topics to be studied. Completed best practices reviews include studies to assist local government officials in developing procedures to privatize local government services, operate 911 centers, and develop cooperative agreements for local road and street repair and maintenance. The Legislative Audit Bureau was authorized 1 FTE position to undertake the reviews. Authority to conduct the reviews and for the position sunset July 1, 1999.

This amendment deletes the sunset and provides funding for 1.0 FTE position (\$41,700 annually) for the Legislative Audit Bureau for Best Practices audits.

The amendment also deletes a Budget & Policy Analyst position within the Department of Commerce (\$47,800 annually). This is a position which has been vacant since July 1998.

Fiscal Impact

None. The funding for the position would come from the deletion of the position within the Department of Commerce.

Statement of Intent

Legislature. Provides funding for 1.0 FTE position for the Legislative Audit Bureau.
