Statement of Intent DPI. BadgerLink funding

Summary This amendment makes several changes to the BadgerLink Program:

- 1) Require that beginning in the second year of the biennium, the Library Technology Services Grant (LTSA) federal monies administered by DPI will be required to fund \$200,000 towards maintaining badgerLink operations, and in subsequent years, that LTSA grant monies will be responsible for 50 percent of program operations.
- 2) Require the UW System and its campuses to eliminate contracts for any electronic database content which is duplicative, or substantially similar to content provided by badgerLink vendors by the end of Dec 31, 2000. Any SEG monies allocated for BadgerLink for the upcoming biennium will be held as s. 13.10 reserve, and UW System shall submit a report to JFC by September 30, 1999 verifying compliance progress and final intent to comply with this section prior to being made available to continue the program.
- 3) Require that in the second year of the biennium, the UW System and member campuses shall contribute a total of 2% of its overall library appropriation for "electronic knowledge resources" to fund BadgerLink operations, and in subsequent years, that contribution shall constitute a total of 5% of BadgerLink program operations
- 4) Further require that in all subsequent Requests For Proposals (RFPs) to continue the BadgerLink program, that one person from a public library in Wisconsin to be chosen by the Governor, and one person representing the UW System to be appointed by the UW System President, be directed to participate in the bid reviewing process to more accurately reflect the broad constituency of BadgerLink users.
- 5) Further require that DPI undertake a feasibility study of providing partial private financial underwriting for the BadgerLink program. The study shall specifically investigate potential mechanisms for raising private monies to replace the share of program costs funded through the TEACH assessment, and shall be completed by September 30, 2000. The study will be conducted using existing departmental resources, and no additional funding or positions will be provided.

Amend the motion to specify that current funding be "sunseted" on June 30, 2001.

Fiscal Impact The fiscal impact of this amendment is a decrease of \$200,000 FED in the second year of the biennium. There will be a corresponding decrease of \$200,000 SEG in the second year of the biennium as well.
