## Summary

Since 1995-96, Wisconsin has participated in the Federal State Court Improvement grant program. This program provides funding to state supreme courts to help state courts improve the handling of child abuse and neglect cases. The Supreme Court received its first federal grant in the 1996-97 period which required a 25 percent state match. The state funding comes from the Supreme Court's general program operations sum sufficient appropriation.

The amendment prohibits the Supreme Court and the Director of State Court from expending any state funds for the purpose of matching federal funds provided under the Federal State Court Improvement grant program. The amendment applies to court improvement grants awarded by the Supreme Court or the Director of State Courts on the effective date of the bill.

## Fiscal Impact

According to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, the Federal State Court Improvement grant program required a state match of \$68,619 (GPR) in 1998-99. Over the biennium, the fiscal effect of this amendment would be to reduce GPR funding by \$137,238.

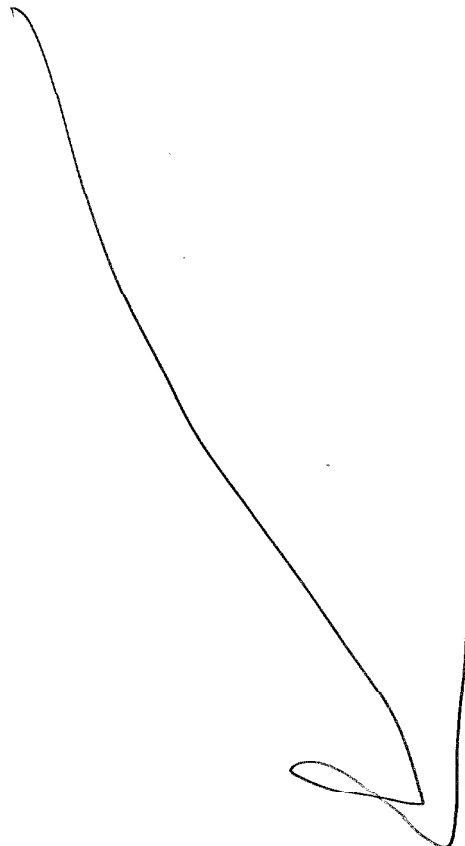
