SECTION 501r. 20.485 (2) (r) of the statutes is created to read:

20.485 **(2)** (r) *Korean War memorial at Plover.* From the heritage state parks and forests trust fund, the amounts in the schedule to provide perpetual care for the Korean War memorial located at Plover in Portage County. This paragraph does not apply after June 30, 2000.".

"Section 720t. 27.016 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

27.016 **(7)** Beginning in fiscal year 1996–97 and for each fiscal year thereafter, any Any moneys not encumbered or expended for grants under sub. (6) from the appropriation under s. 20.370 (1) (eq) or allocated for veterans memorials from the appropriations under s. 20.485 (2) (q) and (r) may be used by the department for the operation and maintenance of the state parks, of the southern state forests and of state recreation areas and by the department of veterans affairs for the protection, restoration and rehabilitation of veterans memorials located in this state.".
