Individual requests O.K.'s for drafting in Caucus

**Each of these provisions should be drafted as individual amendments**

- 1) Rep. Gronemus – Request an amendment to the Assembly Republican Substitute Budget Amendment be drafted that will transfer back to DPI \$353,980 in federal Tech-Prep funds and \$214,636 Carl Perkins leadership funds received under the Carl Perkins Act from the Work-Based Learning Board.
  - 2) Rep. Cullen – Request an amendment to the Assembly Republican Substitute Budget Amendment be drafted that will require that a binding referendum be placed on the April 2000 ballot in Milwaukee seeking public authorization of any plan the MPS Board advances for the construction of new schools.
  - 3) Rep. Sinicki – Request an amendment to the Assembly Republican Substitute Budget Amendment be drafted that would repeal Rep. Kestell's Motion 104 regarding 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade foreign language requirements.
  - 4) Rep. Sherman – Request an amendment to the Assembly Republican Substitute Budget Amendment be drafted that will provide that the Milwaukee Charter Schools and Milwaukee School Choice programs not be funded by deductions from state aids to districts not involved in the program.
  - 5) Rep. Ryba – Request an amendment to the Assembly Republican Substitute Budget Amendment be drafted that would amend the Joint Finance version of the budget regarding Increasing Enrollment Revenue Limit Adjustment. This amendment would repeal the JFC's action and revert to current law regarding declining and increasing enrollment. (LFB Paper 771)
  - 6) Rep. Meyer – Request an amendment to the Assembly Republican Substitute Budget Amendment be drafted that would provide \$130,000 GPR in start-up funding for the Dental Hygiene and Dental Assistant Program in their new Allied Health Sciences facility to be completed in the year 2000. This motion is identical to Rep. Huebsch's motion #150, which failed during Republican Caucus action on the budget. A copy of the motion is attached.

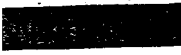

The La Crosse Medical Health Science Consortium has received approval to construct an Allied Health Sciences facility. This motion would provide \$130,000 GPR in start-up funding for a WWTC-La Crosse Dental Hygiene and Dental Assisting Program designed meet the dental needs of the underserved and improve access to care for medical assistance (MA) patients. The program would move into the Allied Health Sciences facility, which is expected to be completed in early 2000. It is expected that the program will not move into the facility until the fall of the year 2000. The majority of the equipment to be used by the dental clinic will be the same equipment used in the dental hygiene/assistant training program. However, there are additional pieces of equipment and installation costs that are over and above what the hygiene program will need to operate its planned educational programming. The requested GPR would cover these additional costs.

The program will have twelve dental chairs that will be used by dental hygienists during their normal curriculum. The opening of the dental clinic will coincide with the beginning of the hygiene and dental assistant classes in the new facility. This clinic and dental equipment will be scheduled to be available for providing the needed dental care in the community on evenings and weekends. The La Crosse area dentists may be supplemented by residents of Marquette University Dental School beginning in 2001, as well as dental hygiene and dental assisting students from WWTC.



The motion would increase GPR expenditures by \$130,000 in one-time start-up funds.

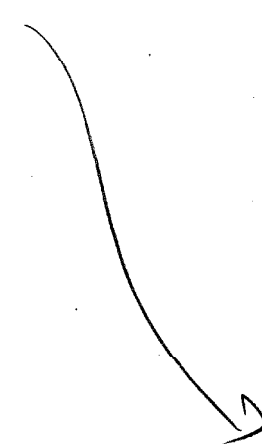
