**Motion:**

Amendment, LRBb0449/1dn, has been drafted for Rep. Joe Plouff, per the request of UW-Stout for the establishment of a casino gaming management course (attached.)

Current statute: **s.945.05 Dealing in gambling devices.** (2) Proof of possession of any device designed exclusively for gaming purposes, which is less than 25 years old, is not in gambling place and is not set up for use, is prima facie evidence of possession with intent to transfer.

Proposed change to statute: **s.945.05(1) (c)** For purposes of definition, any equipment used in a gaming course offered for academic credit from any accredited four year institution of higher education, shall not be considered gaming devices.
