Insert into the statutes at 115.3615 that funds distributed by the state superintendent to agencies may go to serve children from families with incomes up to 165% of the federal poverty guideline.

115.3615 Head start supplement. From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (eh), the state superintendent shall distribute funds to agencies determined by the state superintendent to be eligible for designation as head start agencies under 42 USC 9836 to provide comprehensive health, educational, nutritional, social and other services to economically disadvantaged children and their families. The state superintendent shall distribute the funds in a manner consistent with 42 USC 9831 to 9852 except that there is no matching fund requirement. The state superintendent shall give preference in funding under this section to an agency that is receiving federal funds under 42 USC 9831 to 9852. Funds distributed under this section may be used to match available federal funds under 42 USC 9831 to 9852 only if the funds are used to secure additional federal funds for the purposes under this section.

Head Start is seeking your support to add an amendment to the 1999-2001 budget that would clearly state Head Start can use the state supplement to serve children from families with incomes up to 185% of the federal poverty guideline.

(65%)

There is no additional fiscal impact to the State with this change. It would simply allow Head Start to serve kids that are now being denied these services because of changes in Wisconsin's welfare system under W-2.

Currently, Head Start serves only those families at 100% of the federal poverty guideline. As you can imagine, because of the evolution of Wisconsin's welfare system under W-2, many children are being denied Head Start services because their parent is bumped above the 100% level once they start working in a minimum wage job. Unfortunately, the need of that child does not change just because their parent is now making minimum wage.

Head Start has been able to serve children from welfare families with the greatest need because of your strong commitment over the years. By allowing Head Start to serve children in families above 100% of the federal poverty guideline, Head Start can continue to serve those kids that have the greatest need under W-2.
