Transfer \$3.5 M in GPR funds from 20.370(6)(aa) to 20.115(7)(c) and \$3.0 M in SEG funds from 20.370(6)(aq) to 20.115(7)(qd). *This is an accounting transaction – no increase in funding is being requested.*

The language should be clarified to indicate that the intent is to create an equitable distribution of funding and that the "average" county allocation would amount to \$100,000 and three staff positions. *No fiscal impact.*
