[REDACTED] The Department of Commerce administers a variety of economic development programs for businesses that want to start, expand, or locate their operations in Wisconsin. Commerce provides assistance through low-interest loans, grants, as well as tax credits to business that locate or expand in economically distressed areas.

The Governor's budget recommended the creation of a gaming economic development grant and loan program and a gaming diversification grant and loan program to provide financial assistance to businesses that are located in counties that are affected by Native American gaming operations. The Governor proposed using \$8.0 million in funding from tribal gaming revenues to pay for this new program.

The amendment:

- a) requires the Department of Commerce to make a grant of up to \$1 million for the Swiss Cultural Center in New Glarus, Wisconsin from the Gaming Economic Diversification Grant and Loan Program. The funding scheme outlined in the amendment specifies that \$1 in state funding be matched with \$2 from other sources.
- b) requires the enumeration and allocation of \$1 million (BR) from the Capital Budget for the Swiss Cultural Center in New Glarus, Wisconsin.
- c) specifies that state funding could not exceed \$2 million.

[REDACTED] According to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, the amendment would utilize existing tribal gaming revenues allocated to the Department of Commerce for the Gaming Economic Diversification Grant and Loan program. With respect to the Capital Budget provision, the amendment would require \$1 million (BR) in funding from the Capital Budget.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
- 2 1. Page 15, line 13: after that line insert:
- 3 "SECTION 3im. 13.48 (33) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 13.48 (33) SWISS CULTURAL CENTER. (a) The building commission may authorize
- 5 up to \$1,000,000 in general fund supported borrowing to aid in the construction of
- 6 a Swiss cultural center in the village of New Glarus. The state funding commitment
- 7 under this paragraph shall be in the form of a grant to an organization known as the
- 8 Swiss Cultural Center. Before approving any such state funding commitment, the
- 9 building commission shall determine that the organization known as the Swiss
- 10 Cultural Center has secured additional funding at least equal to \$2,000,000 from

1 nonstate donations for the purpose of constructing a Swiss cultural center in the
2 village of New Glarus.

3 (b) If the building commission authorizes a grant to the organization known as
4 the Swiss Cultural Center under par. (a) and if, for any reason, the facility that is
5 constructed with funds from the grant is not used as a Swiss cultural center in the
6 village of New Glarus, the state shall retain an ownership interest in the facility
7 equal to the amount of the state's grant."

8 **2.** Page 289, line 15: delete "and for the grants under s. 560.139." and
9 substitute ", for the grants under s. 560.139 and for the grant under 1999 Wisconsin
10 Act (this act), section 9110 (7h)."

11 **3.** Page 399, line 25: after "bm," insert "bp".

12 **4.** Page 409, line 24: after that line insert:

13 "SECTION 638x. 20.866 (2) (zbp) of the statutes is created to read:

14 20.866 (2) (zbp) *Swiss cultural center.* From the capital improvement fund, a
15 sum sufficient for the building commission to provide grants to the organization
16 known as the Swiss Cultural Center to aid in the construction of a Swiss cultural
17 center in the village of New Glarus. The state may contract public debt in an amount
18 not to exceed \$1,000,000 for this purpose."

19 **5.** Page 413, line 9: after that line insert:

20 "SECTION 642x. 20.867 (3) (bp) of the statutes is created to read:

21 20.867 (3) (bp) *Principal repayment, interest and rebates.* A sum sufficient to
22 reimburse s. 20.866 (1) (u) for the payment of principal and interest costs incurred
23 in financing the construction of a Swiss cultural center in the village of New Glarus,
24 and to make the payments determined by the building commission under s. 13.488

1 (1) (m) that are attributable to the proceeds of obligations incurred in financing the
2 construction of a Swiss cultural center in the village of New Glarus.”.

3 **6.** Page 1495, line 2: after that line insert (and adjust the appropriate totals
4 accordingly):

5 “(Lm) SWISS CULTURAL CENTER

6 1. *Projects financed by general fund supported borrowing:*

7 Swiss cultural center — New Glarus 1,000,000

8 (Total project all funding sources \$6,000,000)

9 2. *Projects financed by program revenue:*

20 **7.** Page 1500, line 12: after that line insert:

21 “(6g) SWISS CULTURAL CENTER. Notwithstanding section 13.48 (33) of the
22 statutes, as created by this act, the building commission shall not make a grant to
23 the organization known as the Swiss Cultural Center for the Swiss cultural center

1 project enumerated in subsection (1) (Lm) under section 13.48 (33) of the statutes,
2 as created by this act, unless the department of administration has reviewed and
3 approved the plans for the project. Notwithstanding sections 16.85 (1) and 16.855
4 (1) of the statutes, the department of administration shall not supervise any services
5 or work or let any contract for the project. Section 16.87 of the statutes does not apply
6 to the project.”

7 **8.** Page 1507, line 12: after that line insert:

8 “(7h) GRANT FOR SWISS CULTURAL CENTER.

9 (a) Subject to paragraph (b), from the appropriation under section 20.143 (1)
10 (km) of the statutes, as created by this act, the department of commerce shall make
11 a grant in fiscal biennium 1999–2001 to an organization known as the Swiss Cultural
12 Center for construction of a Swiss cultural center in the village of New Glarus.

13 (b) The amount of the grant under paragraph (a) may not exceed \$1,000,000.
14 For every dollar received from the state for the project under paragraph (a), the
15 organization shall provide \$2 in matching funds for the project from a source other
16 than the state.

17 (c) Within 6 months after spending the full amount of the grant under
18 paragraph (a), the organization shall submit to the department of commerce a report
19 detailing how the grant proceeds were used.”
