DESCRIPTION

This amendment would provide \$3 million in program revenue for construction of an Aquaculture Center in Ashland. It would also provide \$250,000 from Indian Gaming Revenue to be appropriated to the Department of Agriculture for a Development and Diversification Grant program and funding for 1 FTE position to coordinate aquaculture activities and research between the Native American facilities as well. Finally, it would appropriate \$50,000 annually to the University of Wisconsin Extension for partnership work between tribes, the private aquaculture industry and appropriate state agencies.

The Budget bill enumerates in the 1999-2001 state building program, a full-scale aquaculture research facility to be built at Ashland and to be operated by the board of regents of the UW System. Under the bill, \$3,000,000 in program revenue supported borrowing is authorized for the construction of the facility. The program revenue that will support the borrowing consists of moneys received by the state from the Indian gaming compacts.

Please prepare a motion to be introduced which will incorporate the following language into the provision for the Ashland Aquaculture Research Center.

- ✓ That the facility is directed to provide the necessary applied research and hands on training to the Native American aquaculture facilities, State Hatcheries and the private aquaculture industry with priorities in the areas of environmental impact and benefits, water quality issues, appropriate water use, fish health science, innovative aquaculture methods and practices, and demonstration, education and outreach activities through the University of Wisconsin Extension.
- ✓ Direct that any board or committee set up to oversee the creation, direction and day to day operation and goals of this facility, be comprised of a majority of those who are either working aquaculturist's, limnologists, fish health professionals, or those who have insight and knowledge of fish farming operations and regulations.
- ✓ Insert language, which clearly defines the revenue stream for the project construction and day to day operation. State that the aquaculture industry will not be responsible in any way for costs related to the construction or operation of this facility without prior industry input and approval. ?
 Not necessary
- ✓ Include \$250,000.00 per year, from Indian Gaming Revenue to be appropriated to the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, for use in the Agriculture Development and Diversification Grants program. These dollars would be used for interim water quality and discharge research, initiated by the Native American aquaculture facilities and the private aquaculture industry or state owned hatcheries. The funding should be available annually until the Ashland project is completed and producing on farm water quality and aquaculture research. These dollars should be available each year beginning in 1999.

- ✓ In addition the Department of Agriculture Trade and Consumer Protection is to be provided 1 FTE position funded at \$65,000.00 to coordinate aquaculture activities and research activities between the Native American facilities, private industries and the UW and other state agencies. Additionally, \$25,000.00 is to be earmarked for the continuation of an LTE position at the Department of Agriculture for the ongoing needs of the aquaculture industry.
 - ✓ The University of Wisconsin Extension should become an integral part of the research ideas and proposals of this facility. The Extension should be partnered with the Native American hatchery facilities, private aquaculture industry and state agencies to provide direction and disseminate the results of practical research to the industry statewide. Funding for the Extension service should be earmarked at \$50,000.00 per year to facilitate this duty.



Becky, the SDC requests the following be drafted-- the major change being deleting \$250,000 PR annually from the Commerce Indian gaming economic development appropriation, 20.143 (1) kj. The net fiscal effect is \$0 and 1.0 additional position

Delete \$250,000 PR annually from the Commerce Indian gaming economic development appropriation and provide \$250,000 PR annually and one position from tribal gaming revenues for grants under the DATCP Agricultural Development and Diversification grant program to Native American aquaculture facilities, the private aquaculture industry or state owned hatcheries to conduct interim water quality and discharge research. Of the \$250,000, provide \$65,000 annually and a position to coordinate aquaculture activities and research between Native American aquaculture facilities, the private aquaculture industry, the University of Wisconsin System and other state agencies. Sunset the grants and the \$250,000 annual appropriation increase when an aquaculture center in Ashland begins producing aquaculture research.
