 - **895.78 Limiting felon's right to damages. (1)** A person whose real or personal property is damaged in the course of the person committing an act that constituted a felony for which he or she was convicted may not recover for that damage.
 - **(2)** A person who is killed or injured in the course of the person committing an act that constituted a felony for which he or she was convicted may not recover for that death or injury.".
 - **2.** Page 1603, line 24: after that line insert:

"(3e) Limit on Felon's right to damages. The treatment of section 895.78 of the
statutes first applies to a death or injury that occurs on the effective date of this
subsection.".
