**St. Clare Health Mission - Sparta, WI**  
Proposed Budget Amendment

CN 4203

Under current law, the Wisconcare program provides primary health care services to underinsured and unemployed persons through an organized network of medical providers. The program, which operates in only 17 counties in the state – none of which are in West-central Wisconsin, serves approximately one thousand persons per year at a cost of \$1.5 million in program revenue funded through an assessment on hospitals.

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 to Assembly Bill 133 funds Wisconcare at \$1.5 million annually, with a \$300,000 balance from the 1997-99 biennium scheduled to be lapsed into the program fund.

**Motion:** Provide \$50,000 PR in 1999-00 from the Wisconcare program balance to support a one-time appropriation to the St. Clare Health Mission in Sparta. The St. Clare Health Mission, which is staffed by volunteer health care providers, has been providing primary health care and disease management services to low-income families in Western Wisconsin for nearly three years.

The Medical Director of the St. Clare Health Mission, Dr. Patricia Raftery, estimates that \$50,000 would allow the St. Clare Health Mission to serve 1400 future patients – a significantly better return on the investment of funds than the Wisconcare program. Furthermore, this motion appropriates funding from the existing balance of Wisconcare funding, and therefore does not decrease the \$1.5 million annual appropriation for the Wisconcare program during the 1999-2001
