SECTION 1. 16.71 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

16.71 (4) The department of administration shall delegate authority to award leases under s. 85.15 to the department of transportation. This delegation may be withdrawn by the department of administration only with the consent of, and in accordance with the terms specified by, the joint committee on finance, for failure to comply with applicable leasing rules, procedures or statutory requirements. Withdrawal of authority delegated under this subsection does not affect any lease awarded under s. 85.15.

SECTION 2. 85.15 of the statutes is renumbered 85.15 (1).

SECTION 3. 85.15 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

85.15 (2) (a) In this subsection: 1. "Eligible lessee" means a business that is one of the 10 businesses nearest the park and ride lot having the same industry number classification set forth in the Standard Industrial Classification Manual, 1987 edition, published by the U.S. office of management and budget.

1. In this paragraph,

(a) "Park and ride facility" means a facility with a parking lot and, within a reasonable walking distance, a station or transfer point where commuters access a mass transit system.

(b) The department, in accordance with s. 16.71 (4), may lease any building, land or structure of a park and ride facility to any eligible lessee for the purpose of furnishing and distributing tangible personal property or taxable services by an eligible lessee to individuals who use the park and ride facility, if the building, land or structure is unused and not needed for the facility's operations. Such leases shall be awarded by competitive bid procedures under s. 16.75 or negotiated. No lease under this paragraph may have a term exceeding 15 years. The net proceeds of any
