"Intelligent transportation systems" means any application or use of new or existing electronic or computer technologies such as roadway detector loops, closed circuit television, variable message signs, ramp meters, integrated traffic signal systems or other specialized computer or technical systems that measure and manage traffic flow and any personnel utilized in the design, construction or operation of any such systems, on highways and other transportation systems for the purpose of incident management, traffic flow management, congestion avoidance, real time traveler information, or similar purposes; provided, however that such electronic or computer technologies which are physically integrated with and installed as part of a larger highway construction project shall not be considered intelligent transportation systems."

Section 4. 84.013(2)(c) of the statutes is created to read:

"84.013(2)(c). Subsequent to June 30, 2000, the department shall install, maintain, and replace intelligent transportation systems elements solely from the appropriations under s. 20.395(3)(gq) to (gx)."

Nonstatutory Provisions. Add to § 9128 the following:

"( ). No later than April 30, 2000, the department of transportation shall prepare a report to the legislature, in the manner provided under section 13.172(2) of the statutes, on the planned funding and use of intelligent transportation systems for the fiscal year 2000-2001, including recommendations concerning transfer of intelligent transportation systems funding from s. 20.395(3)(bq) to (ix) to s. 20.395(3)(gq) to (gx). The department shall submit the report to the co-chairpersons of the joint committee on finance for consideration at the 2nd quarterly meeting of the committee under section 13.10 of the statutes in the year 2000. Subsequent to June 30, 2000, the department may not utilize any appropriations under s. 20.395(3)(bq) to (ix) for intelligent transportation systems."


