

1 **SECTION 1.** 20.255 (2) (ac) of the statutes is amended to read:

2 20.255 (2) (ac) *General equalization aids.* A sum sufficient for the payment of
3 educational aids under ss. 121.08, 121.09 and 121.105 and subch. VI of ch. 121 equal
4 to ~~\$3,318,488,800 in the 1997-98 fiscal year, equal to \$3,460,133,800~~ \$3,768,344,300
5 in the ~~1998-99~~ 1999-2000 fiscal year and equal to the amount determined by the
6 joint committee on finance under s. 121.15 (3m) (c) in each fiscal year thereafter, less
7 the amount appropriated under par. (bi).

8 **SECTION 2.** 118.40 (2r) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 118.40 (2r) (e) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (fm), the department
10 shall pay to the operator of the charter school an amount equal to the shared cost per
11 ~~member in the previous school year of the school district operating under ch. 119~~ sum
12 of the amount paid per pupil under this paragraph in the previous school year and
13 the amount of revenue increase per pupil allowed under subch. VII of ch. 121 in the
14 current school year, multiplied by the number of pupils attending the charter school.
