previous owner to claim the credit for the property. However, for a variety of reasons—death, relocation or resistance on the part of the seller—a new owner may be unable to obtain the required signature on the credit application. As a result, the new owner will be denied the credit even though the property would have qualified. Because Wisconsin Act 5 was enacted in late July, and credit applications not mailed out until late September, many of this year's home buyers will not receive the credit for 1999 taxes.

An amendment is needed to allow new owners of property to claim the credit and provide an application procedure for such claims to facilitate administration of the credit when ownership changes. Specifically create a provision in s. 79.10(10) to read as follows:

If a property that has been sold qualifies for the credit because the seller used the property as his or her primary residence on the certification date, the purchaser of the property may apply for the credit on a form prescribed by the department of revenue. The applicant shall attest that to his or her knowledge, the property was used as a primary residence by the owner of the property as of the certification date. This claim is valid only for the year of the sale. The purchaser shall claim the credit for future years by making application as provided under par. (a) or (b).

The change first applies to the lottery and gaming credit applied to the property taxes levied in 1999, payable in 2000.

## TRANSPORTATION

### Amtrak Milwaukee-Chicago Rail Passenger Service Funding Reestimate

Reallocate transportation fund SEG and FED funds between the highway rehabilitation and rail passenger service appropriations to reflect a change in the amount of federal funds that can be used to support the Amtrak Hiawatha Line service between Milwaukee and Chicago. Federal funding eligibility for the project has been established at 80% of costs by the Federal Highway Administration, rather than the 90% initially estimated in the budget. Transfer \$371,300 SEG from the state highway rehabilitation appropriation to the state rail passenger service appropriation and transfer \$371,300 FED from the federal rail passenger service appropriation to the federal appropriation for state highway rehabilitation to address this reestimate. ~~This change will have no net impact on program or overall funding levels in the transportation budget.~~

## WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

### 1. Transfer Wagner-Peyser Funding to Work-Based Learning Board

61853 Provide \$103,800 PR in 1999-00, \$106,100 PR in 2000-01 and 2.20 PR positions, and delete 2.20 FED positions, and create a program revenue appropriation under the Work-Based Learning Board to transfer 2.20 positions from the Connecting Education to Work Division of DWD to the Board. These positions are funded by federal Wagner-Peyser Act funds and already exist within the larger DWD budget. The positions should have been moved to the board with the transfer of other functions.
